

The Thought Process and Behavior of a Regenerate Person

1 Corinthians 3:1-4

Seek unity

- Christ is not divided
- Religious ceremonies, like baptism, do not save
- The message of Christ's death is what saves
- The skill of the messenger does not save
- The message of the cross sounds fool, but it is the wisdom of God
- The wisdom of the world does not save

Seek Unity (cont.)

- God does not operate according to human standards or values
- God has provided you with everything in Jesus Christ: wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, redemption; you are complete or mature
- The message of the cross is accompanied by the power of God not by the power of man
- The message of the cross gives believers access to the mind of Christ through the Spirit

Two Kinds of People

The Natural Man

- He is of this world
- He has worldly wisdom
- He operates according to the values of this world
- He considers spiritual values as foolishness

The Man who received the Spirit

- He has the mind of Christ
- He is part of the mature or complete
- He reflects on all things
- He judges according to spiritual principles

Function as a regenerate person

- Reflect on your behavior (1 Corinthians 3:1-4)

1 Corinthians 2:12

- Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

Hebrews 6:1-3

- Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary *principles* of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of **repentance** from dead works and of **faith** toward God, of the doctrine of **baptisms**, of **laying on of hands**, of **resurrection** of the dead, and of **eternal judgment**. And this we will do if God permits.

Hebrews 5:11-12

■ of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become **dull of hearing**. For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again **the first principles of the oracles of God**; and you have come to need **milk** and not solid food.

Hebrews 5:13-14

- For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, *that is*, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Galatians 5:19-21

- Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, **contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like**; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told *you* in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

1 Peter 2:1-3

- Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the Lord *is* gracious.

1 Corinthians 2:12

- Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.
