


The Word Became Human: Come and See the Invisible God

John 1:14-18




The Prologue of John's Gospel

Luke 7:11-12 KJV

- And it came to pass the day after, that he went into a city called Nain; and many of his disciples went with him, and much people. Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the **only** son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her

Luke 8:41-42 KJV

- And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his house: For he had one **only** daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged him

Luke 9:37-38 KJV


- And it came to pass, that on the next day, when they were come down from the hill, much people met him. And, behold, a man of the company cried out, saying, Master, I beseech thee, look upon my son: for he is mine **only** child.

Hebrews 11:17 KJV

- By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his **only begotten son**,

1 John 4:9

- In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His **only begotten** Son into the world, that we might live through Him.

Acts 17:28-30

- "for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.' Therefore, since we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like gold or silver or stone, something shaped by art and man's devising. Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent

Hebrews 10:28

- Anyone who has rejected Moses' law **dies without mercy** on the testimony of two or three witnesses.

The Mosaic Law

- It shows that sin can be dealt with
- It shows God's holiness
- It prophesizes about the ultimate solution for sin
- It shows God's favorable disposition to deal with the problem of sin
- It brings out the guiltiness and helplessness of man
- It was a way to show the believers' faith

Hebrews 10:1-2


- For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, **can never** with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, **make those who approach perfect**. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins.

Galatians 3:24

- Therefore the law was our **tutor** to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

Hebrews 8:6

- But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also **Mediator of a better covenant**, which was established on better promises.
