




John 14:12-17




Statements Philip did not grasp


John 10:30-33

- "I and *My Father* are one." Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. Jesus answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?" The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because *You*, being a Man, make *Yourself* God."






John 5:19-21

- Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but **what He sees the Father do**; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. For **the Father loves the Son**, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel. For as the **Father raises the dead and gives life to them**, even so the Son gives life to whom He will.




Luke 10:17-20

- Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name."
- And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless **do not rejoice in this**, that the spirits are subject to you, **but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.**"




Luke 10:21-22

- In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and **no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and *the one* to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him*.**"




Luke 10:23-24

- Then He turned to *His* disciples and said privately, "**Blessed are the eyes which see the things you see**; for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen *it*, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard *it*."




Luke 15:7, 10

- "I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over **one sinner who repents** than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.
- "Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God **over one sinner who repents.**"




Luke 15:32

- 'It was right that we should make merry and be glad, for **your brother was dead and is alive again**, and **was lost and is found**.' "




John 4:35-36

- "Do you not say, 'There are still four months and *then* comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! And he who reaps receives wages, and **gathers fruit for eternal life**, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together.




James 5:19-20

- Brethren, if anyone among you **wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back**, let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of **his way** will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.




Matthew 9:36-38

- But when He saw the multitudes, He was **moved with compassion for them**, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly *is* plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore **pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.**"




Get involved in spiritual transformations

- **Proverbs 11:30** The fruit of the righteous *is* a tree of life, And **he who wins souls *is* wise.**






Philippians 2:6-9

- who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of death*, even the death of the cross. Therefore **God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name**,




Philippians 4:13

- I can do **all things** through Christ who strengthens me.






John 13:34-35

- "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."




Romans 13:8-10

- Owe no one anything except to **love one another**, for **he who loves another has fulfilled the law**. For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not bear false witness," "You shall not covet," and if *there is* any other commandment, are ***all summed up in this saying, namely, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."*** Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore **love is the fulfillment of the law**.




Matthew 22:36-40

- "Teacher, which *is* the great commandment in the law?"
- Jesus said to him, " 'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is *the* first and great commandment. And *the* second *is* like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' **On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.**"






1 John 2:1


Acts 10:45

- And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because **the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.**




Acts 13:2

- As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, **the Holy Spirit said**, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."




Acts 15:28-29


Ephesians 2:17-18
