John 14:18-26



Jesus is present with His people

- He promised to return (John 14:18)

John 2:19-21

- Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."
- Then the Jews said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?"
- But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

John 2:22

- Therefore, when He had risen from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this to them; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had said.

Jesus enabled to come back to life

- **John 5:26** "For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself,
- **John 10:17-18** "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

Luke 18:31-33

- Then He took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be accomplished. For He will be delivered to the Gentiles and will be mocked and insulted and spit upon. **They will scourge *Him* and kill *Him*.** And the third day He will rise again."

Luke 18:34

- But they understood none of these things; this saying was hidden from them, and they did not know the things which were spoken.



Jesus is present with His people

John 12:36

- "While you have the light, believe in the light, that you may become sons of light." These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.

1 Corinthians 15:3-5

- For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.

1 Corinthians 15:6-8

- After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

John 5:24-25

- " Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life. Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; and those who hear will live.

John 5:28-29


- "Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which **all** who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth -- those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.

John 6:40

- "And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."

Jesus was from above

- **John 3:13** "No one has ascended to heaven but **He who came down from heaven, that is**, the Son of Man who is in heaven.
- **John 8:23-24** And He said to them, "You are from beneath; **I am from above**. You are of this world; **I am not of this world**. Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

Matthew 10:2-4


- Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and **Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus**; Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.

Mark 3:16-19

- Simon, to whom He gave the name Peter; James the son of Zebedee and John the brother of James, to whom He gave the name Boanerges, that is, "Sons of Thunder"; Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, **Thaddaeus**, Simon the Cananite; and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him. And they went into a house.

Luke 6:13-16

- And when it was day, He called His disciples to *Himself*; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles: Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew; Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot; **Judas the son of James**, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor.




Acts 1:13

- And when they had entered, they went up into the upper room where they were staying: Peter, James, John, and Andrew; Philip and Thomas; Bartholomew and Matthew; James *the son of Alpheus* and Simon the Zealot; and Judas *the son of James*.

John 14:16-17




