John 15:1-11

Cling to Jesus: the significance of your life depends on it

- ◆ He is the vine and you are a branch (John 15:1-4)

John 13:10-11, 8

- Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash *his* feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you." For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "You are not all clean."
- Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me."

Galatians 5:22-23

- But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Fruits of the Branches

- **Matthew 3:8** "Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance,
- **Luke 3:10-11** So the people asked him, saying, "What shall we do then?" He answered and said to them, "He who has two tunics, let him give to him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise."

Luke 3:12-14

- Then tax collectors also came to be baptized, and said to him, "Teacher, what shall we do?" And he said to them, "Collect no more than what is appointed for you." Likewise the soldiers asked him, saying, "And what shall we do?" So he said to them, "Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages."

2 Corinthians 9:10-11

- Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have *sown* and *increase the fruits of your righteousness*, while *you are* enriched in everything for all *liberality*, which causes *thanksgiving* through us to God.

Ephesians 5:9-10


- (for the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.
