 Jesus was not a rebel or evildoer (John 18:28-32)

Passover Week

- Thursday, Nisan 14th, Passover meal
- Friday, Nisan 15th, day of Preparation, arrest and crucifixion take place
- Saturday, Nisan 16th, special Sabbath, day after the day of Preparation, no work is done
- Sunday, Nisan 17th, Resurrection Sunday
- Thursday, Nisan 21st, last day of Passover

Acts 11:2-3

- And when Peter came up to Jerusalem, those of the circumcision contended with him, saying, "You went in to uncircumcised men and ate with them!"

Luke 23:2

- And they began to accuse Him, saying, "We found this *fellow* perverting the nation, and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ, a King."

Luke 23:5

- But they were the more fierce, saying, "He stirs up the people, teaching throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee to this place."

Leviticus 24:16

- 'And whoever blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death. All the congregation **shall certainly stone him**, the stranger as well as him who is born in the land. When he blasphemes the name *of the Lord*, he shall be put to death.

John 8:59

- Then they took up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

John 10:32-33

- Jesus answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?" The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."

John 3:14-15

- "And as Moses **lifted up the serpent** in the wilderness, even so must **the Son of Man** be **lifted up**, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

John 12:31-33

- "Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out. And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all *peoples* to Myself."
- This He said, signifying by what death He would die.

Psalm 22:16-17

- For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet; I can count all My bones. They look *and* stare at Me.

Deuteronomy 21:22-23

- " If a man has committed a sin deserving of death, and he is put to death, **and you hang him on a tree**, his body shall not remain overnight on the tree, but you shall surely bury him that day, so that you do not defile the land which the LORD your God is giving you *as* an inheritance; for he who is hanged is accursed of God.

Galatians 3:13

- Christ has **redeemed** us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree"),

John 3:31-32

- "He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all. And what He has seen and heard, that He testifies; and no one receives His testimony.

John 3:33-34

- "He who has received His testimony has certified that God is true. For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure.

John 3:11-13

- "Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness. If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things? No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, *that is*, the Son of Man who is in heaven.
