Consider Jesus, God's Revelation

- He didn't speak and act in an isolated environment (John 5:31-32)
- He was the reason for John's ministry (John 5:33-35)

John 1:7-8

- This man came for a witness, to **bear witness of the Light**, that **all through him might believe**. He was not that Light, but *was sent* to bear witness of that Light.

Testimony of John the Baptist

- Jesus was higher in rank and before Him in time: Jesus was divine
- Jesus was the Son of God indwelled by the Holy Spirit
- Jesus Baptizes with the Holy Spirit
- Jesus speaks the words of God
- Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

1 Timothy 2:4

- who [God our Savior] desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

John 5:25

- "Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; and those who hear will live.

John 3:2

- This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that **You are a teacher come from God**; for no one can do **these signs** that You do unless **God is with him**."

John 5:19

- Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but **what He sees the Father do**; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

Hebrews 1:1-2a

- God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days **spoken to us by *His* Son,**

John 14:9-10

- Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? **He who has seen Me has seen the Father**; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? **Do you not believe** that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me?"

John 1:14

- And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Hebrews 1:3

- who being **the brightness of *His* glory** and the **express image of His person**, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

2 Corinthians 3:14-16

- But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted **in the reading of the Old Testament**, because the *veil* is taken away in Christ. But even to this day, when Moses is read, a **veil lies on their heart**. Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the **veil is taken away**.

- but *he is* a Jew who *is one* inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise *is* not from men but from God.
