


Micah 1:8-16

2 Chronicles 28:24-25

- So Ahaz gathered the articles of the house of God, cut in pieces the articles of the house of God, **shut up the doors of the house of the LORD**, and made for himself altars in every corner of Jerusalem. And **in every single city of Judah** he **made high places to burn incense to other gods**, and provoked to anger the LORD God of his fathers.



Trust God: Lack of trust in God ends up in...

- Inescapable hurt (Micah 1:8-9)
- Humiliation (Micah 1:10-11a)



2 Samuel 1:19-20

- "The beauty of Israel is slain on your high places! How the mighty have fallen! **Tell it not in Gath**, Proclaim *it* not in the streets of Ashkelon -- Lest the daughters of the Philistines rejoice, Lest the daughters of the uncircumcised triumph.

- Defeat (Micah 1:11b)
- Distress (Micah 1:12)
- Loss (Micah 1:13-14a)

- Power shifts (Micah 1:15)
- A not very promising future (Micah 1:16)
