

The God Who Forgives

Micah 7:18-20

Exodus 34:6-7

- And the LORD passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD God, **merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin**, by no means clearing *the guilty*, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children's children to the third and the fourth generation."

Exodus 24:9-11

- Then Moses went up, also Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and **they saw the God of Israel**. And *there* was under His feet as it were a paved work of sapphire stone, and it was like the very heavens in *its* clarity. But on the nobles of the children of Israel He did not lay His hand. **So they saw God, and they ate and drank.**

Exodus 34:8-9

- So Moses made haste and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshiped. Then he said, "If now I have found grace in Your sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray, go among us, even though we are a stiff-necked people; and **pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us as Your inheritance.**"

- *Through* the LORD's **mercies** we are not consumed, Because His **compassions** fail not. ²³
They are new every morning; Great *is* Your faithfulness.

Isaiah 53:5-6

- But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And **the LORD** has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

Isaiah 49:6

- Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also give You as a **light to the Gentiles**, That You should **be My salvation to the ends of the earth.**' "

Mark 10:26-27

- And they were greatly astonished, saying among themselves, "Who then can be saved?"
- But Jesus looked at them and said, "**With men *it is* impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible.**"

Colossians 2:13

- And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, **having forgiven you all trespasses,**

Romans 3:1-4

- What advantage then has the Jew, or what *is* the profit of circumcision? Much in every way! Chiefly because **to them were committed the oracles of God**.
- For what if some did not believe? **Will their unbelief make the faithfulness of God without effect? Certainly not!** Indeed, let God be true but every man a liar. As it is written: "That You may be justified in Your words, And may overcome when You are judged."

Genesis 50:24-25

- And Joseph said to his brethren, "I am dying; but God will surely visit you, and bring you out of this land to the land of **which He swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.**" Then Joseph took an oath from the children of Israel, saying, "**God will surely visit you**, and you shall carry up my bones from here."

Hebrews 6:17-18

- Thus God, determining **to show** more abundantly to the heirs of promise **the immutability of His counsel, confirmed *it* by an oath**, that by two immutable things, in which it *is* impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, **who have fled for refuge** to lay hold of the hope set before *us*.
