Psalm 107



Hebrew Terms



- **To give thanks** – (to throw) to confess, to praise, to make a public proclamation of God's attributes and His works.
- **The LORD** – (YHWH) personal name of the God of Israel: Yahweh or Jehovah. It means *He Is* (faithful presence).
- **Mercy** – (hesed) also translated *steadfast love, lovingkindness, or goodness*. Describes God's love.

- ...since *it is* a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you, and to *give* you who are troubled **rest** with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels.

- "And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."

- It satisfies fully (Psalm 107:4-9)
- It sets people free (Psalm 107:10-16)
- It heals (Psalm 107:17-22)
- It grants success (Psalm 107:23-32)
- It directs God's providence (Psalm 107:33-41)
- It is a source of joy (Psalm 107:42-43)
